



Berry Saltbush

Name	Scientific	Rhagodia baccata
	Common	Berry Saltbush
Description		A straggly shrub up to 2 metres tall.
Leaves		The leaves are slightly fleshy, grey-green in colour, 4 m long and 8mm wide.
Flowers		Small cream, yellow or green flowers produced on the female plants in clusters at the end of the stems between March and June.
Fruits		Small, deep red, fleshy berries. Small birds called silvereyes eat the red berries.
Did you know?		Berry saltbush has separate male and female plants, with the red fruits forming on the female plant.
